The meeting of the Board of Directors of the Economic Development Authority of the City of Lynchburg, Virginia, was held in City Council Chambers, 1st Floor, City Hall, 900 Church Street, Lynchburg, Virginia, at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, January 16, 2025, on call of the Chairman and upon written notice to all of the Directors. Ms. Upshur reported on several matters of interest from the Staff Report attached to these minutes. She highlighted the fact that the Directors need to fill out the Statement of Economic Interest and that she would assist and make sure that each Director received the form which needed to be submitted by February 1st.
